## 10 TERRIFYING CYBERSECURITY STATISTICS MANUFACTURERS CAN'T IGNORE

Vampires and ghosts come out during Halloween, but **cyber criminals lurk year-round.**Check out these terrifying statistics to see how the manufacturing industry is impacted by cyberattacks.

Manufacturing companies account for **nearly a quarter** of all ransomware attacks in the United States (23%).<sup>1</sup>

The average cost of recovery from a ransomware attack is nearly \$2 million.<sup>2</sup>

\$17,700 is lost every minute due to a phishing attack.<sup>3</sup>

**57% of organizations** see weekly or daily phishing attempts.<sup>4</sup>

Organizations up to 250 employees have the highest targeted malicious email rate at 1 in 323.<sup>5</sup>

90% of organizations in the manufacturing sector had at least one cyber incident in 2021, while 63% had three or more incidents. 6

Only **59% of manufacturers** have a well-defined plan to handle cyber incidents.<sup>7</sup>

**47% of attacks** on manufacturers are caused by software vulnerabilities.<sup>8</sup>

Malware is used in 62% of supply chain attacks.<sup>9</sup>

**75% of cyber incidents** originate from within an organization.<sup>10</sup>
